

As the Cairn Terrier Club Centenary weekend draws near, we thought it would be helpful for exhibitors and others to have a few more details about the proceedings.

We are delighted with the entry for the shows - 212 dogs for the CTC Show on Saturday and 211 for the Joint Show on Sunday. Because of this large entry we would like to emphasize that judging will start **promptly** at 9.30am each day.

After lunch on Saturday, there will be a cake - cutting ceremony before the commencement of the bitch judging. As this will add a little time to the afternoon's proceedings, we will have only a very short lunch break of no more than 20 minutes. It is vital that we commence the afternoon programme promptly so that we can enjoy the bitch judging in a relaxed manner without any need to rush the proceedings.

We suggest, therefore, that you take your lunch whenever it is convenient throughout the late morning and early afternoon. This will also prevent a rush on the cafeteria which might result in some people not being served in time for the start of the afternoon's programme.

Similarly, on the Sunday, the Parade of Champions will take place just before the start of the bitch judging. The timing of the completion of judging on Sunday is not quite as vital as on Saturday when there is a further programme in the evening, but a "staggering" of lunch times may again be advisable to avoid pressure on the cafeteria.

Those bringing dogs for eye testing on Sunday are reminded that the dogs must be microchipped, and the Kennel Club registration form must be produced.
