DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

IN THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS, ACHALLENGE CERTIFICATE INCLUDES ANY SHOWAWARD THAT COUNTS TOWARDS THE TITLE OF CHAMPION UNDER THE RULES OF ANY GOVERNING BODY RECOGNISED BY THE KENNEL CLUB. WINNERS AT CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE SHOWN IN BREED CLASSES WHERE CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE ARE NOT ON OFFER SHALL BE COUNTED AS WINNERS AT OPEN SHOWS. IN THE CASE OF A DOG OWNED IN PART BY SEVERAL AND ENTERED IN BREED CLASSES OR OPENING TO BREEDERS SPECIALS, EACH PARTNER MUST ATTEND THE OPEN ENTRY BE A MEMBER OF THE SOCIETY.

IN ESTIMATING THE NUMBER OF AWARDS WON, ALL WINNS UP TO AND INCLUDING THE 7TH DAY BEFORE THE DATE OF CLOSING OF ENTRIES SHALL BE COUNTED WHEN ENTERING FOR ANY CLASS. (E. 1ST FEBRUARY 2014)

WINNERS AT VARIETY CLASSES DO NOT COUNT FOR ENTRY IN BREED CLASSES, BUT WHEN ENTERING FOR VARIETY CLASSES, WINNERS IN BOTH BREED AND VARIETY CLASSES MUST BE COUNTED A FIRST PRIZE DOES NOT INCLUDE SPECIAL PRIZES OR VARIETY VALUE

ADDS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY IN VARIETY CLASSES UNLESS ALSO ENTERED & SUBSEQUENTLY EXHIBITED IN A BREED CLASS WHERE SUCH A CLASS IS PROVIDED FOR WHICH IS ELIGIBLE EXEMPTIONS FROM THE REGULATION ARE:-

- (1) AP PUPPY UNLESS A GYSS FOR DOGS UNDER 12 MONTHS OF AGE FOR WHICH IS ELIGIBLE IS PROVIDED FOR THE BREED.
- (2) A DOG IN ANY VARIETY OR VETERNARY CLASS.
- (3) AS PROVIDED IN A NEW VETERNARY CLASS.
- (4) A DOG WHICH IS NOT BEFORE THE JUDGE IN A GYSS FOR A CLASS THAT A DOG HAS BEEN ENTERED WHICH IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE EXHIBIT OR MAY BE SO SEEN IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:-
 - (1) WITHDRAWAL - THE DOG MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM A COMPETITION SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS OF THE REGULATION S90 AND 22 TRANSFER.
 - (2) TRANSFER.
 - (3) IF A DOG IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A CLASS OR CLASSES AS REGARDS ITS COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER IT TO THE EQUIVALENT CLASS OR CLASSES FOR THE CORRECT COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT AND IN THE EVENT OF THERE BEING NO EQUIVALENT CLASS, MINOR PUPPY & PUPPY EXCEPTED, TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.
 - (4) IF A DOG IS ENTERED IN A CORRECT CLASS IN A MINOR PUPPY CLASS OR PUPPY CLASS WHICH IS OVER AGE BUT UNDER 12 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE OR 18 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE RESPECTIVELY, THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER THE EXHIBIT TO THE PUPPY CLASS OR THE MINOR CLASS RESPECTIVELY FOR THE CORRECT COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT AND IN THE EVENT OF THERE BEING NO PUPPY OR MINOR CLASS RESPECTIVELY TO THE OPEN CLASS FOR THE CORRECT COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.
 - (5) IF FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN THAT ABOVE, THE SHOW SECRETARY SHALL TRANSFER IT TO THE OPEN CLASS OR THE CORRECT COLOUR, SEX, WEIGHT OR HEIGHT.
 - (6) IF AN EXHIBIT ARRIVES LATE AND MISSES A CLASS, EVEN IF IT IS THE ONLY CLASS IN WHICH IT IS ENTERED, THE DOG MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANY OTHER CLASS.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

MINOR PUPPY FOR DOGS OF 68 & NOT EXCEEDING 90 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1ST DAY OF THE SHOW.

PUPPY FOR DOGS OF 68 & NOT EXCEEDING 18 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1ST DAY OF THE SHOW.

JUNIOR FOR DOGS OF 68 & NOT EXCEEDING 18 CALENDAR MONTHS OF AGE ON THE 1ST DAY OF THE SHOW.

NOVICE PUPPY WHICH HAVE NOT WON THE OPEN OR FIRST PRIZES AT ANY SHOW IN MINOR PUPPY, SPECIAL MINOR PUPPY, PUPPY & SPECIAL PUPPY CLASSES EXCEPTED WHEN ENTERED RESTRICTED OR NOT.

POST GRADUATE FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON THE OPEN OR FIRST PRIZES AT ANY SHOW IN POST GRADUATE, MINOR LIMIT, MD.

MD LIMIT LIMIT AND OPEN CLASSES WHEN ENTERED RESTRICTED OR NOT.

OPEN FOR DOGS WHICH HAVE NOT WON THE OPEN OR FIRST PRIZES AT OPEN OR CHAMPIONSHIPS SHOWS IN MD LIMIT, MD AND OPEN CLASSES, CONFIRMED OTHER REED WITH ENTERED RESTRICTED OR NOT FOR ALL DOGS OF ALL BREEDS FOR WHICH THE CLASS IS PROVIDED AND ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY AT THE SHOW.

KENNEL CLUB SHOW REGULATION - F REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

- 1) These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition at a show. When a dog is found to have been prepared for exhibition in contravention of these regulations the exhibitor will be dealt with as if a complaint under Kennel Club Rule 42 had been lodged against them and proved to the satisfaction of the General Committee without prejudice to the right of the exhibitor to make representations to the General Committee in mitigation of the penalty to be imposed at the discretion of the General Committee under Rule 42. The dog will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and any award gained thereat.
- 2) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition either before or at the show. Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat of a dog at the time of exhibition. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed and nothing may be done, calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive, except:-
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee
 - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any kind.
 - (c) The shortening of tails of customary docked breeds.
 - (d) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.
- 3) The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have written directives from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 4) Any individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 5) Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
- 6) **NOTE**

The Officers and Committee do not accept responsibility for any products advertised or sold by Stall Holders and/or Trade Stands at this show. Exhibitors are reminded that products on sale by Trade Stands for the preparation and grooming of dogs may not meet the requirements for the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

KENNEL CLUB RULE F(1), 17h

The attraction of attention of exhibits by any method from outside the ring is prohibited, it is the duty of the Judge, Steward or Show Management noticing such attraction to ask that it cease.
